All assistantship stipends are increasing in '24-25

The Chancellor and Academic Affairs will provide funding to increase stipends for all graduate students on assistantships, and guidance about how that will happen is forthcoming.

In the meantime, we advise that you set up NinerWorks as you normally would for new students, so they have their offers, and wait for the guidance before setting up NinerWorks actions for continuing students. That way, fewer NinerWorks actions will need to be revised.

Deadlines

April 1st:

- Nominate **new** students for GASP and MTART
- Set up assistantships for **new** students in NinerWorks
- If you have students funded by the Graduate School, fill out the Google sheet. We will set up the NinerWorks actions for new students.

The funding team will be sure to send notification of offers to new students before April 15th.



Tech Tip

In eGPS, you can see a list of all of your students, organized in a table with some information. One important item you might want to know is each students' NC residency, and it's there in the table. You can also copy and paste this information into a spreadsheet.
