



## Fellowship Application Incentive Program (FAIP) '18-19

Students can earn money by applying for fellowships!

<b>Who</b>	Doctoral students
<b>What</b>	\$500 for applying to an allowed fellowship (up to two) \$1,500 if student wins the fellowship (just one)
<b>Type of Fellowship Allowed</b>	External fellowship for which the student is eligible. Travel grants for conferences or field research. Grants for doctoral dissertation research as PI or co-PI.
<b>Amount of Fellowship Required</b>	\$5,000 minimum dollar value.
<b>Deadlines for the FAIP</b>	Fill out the form to enroll by February 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2019. Student must send proof of fellowship application by May 15 <sup>th</sup> , 2019.
<b>Method to Apply for the FAIP</b>	Fill out <a href="#">this form</a> by the FAIP deadline ( <a href="https://goo.gl/forms/0VYFSx9qktKO8W3D3">https://goo.gl/forms/0VYFSx9qktKO8W3D3</a> ). Once student applies for fellowship, they must send proof to Julie Goodliffe ( <a href="mailto:jmgoodli@uncc.edu">jmgoodli@uncc.edu</a> ) to be eligible for payment.
<b>Deadline to Apply for the Fellowship</b>	Before May 15 <sup>th</sup> , 2019.
<b>Deadline to Inform Grad School the Results</b>	May 15 <sup>th</sup> , 2019. Any student who obtains an FAIP-enrolled fellowship must send proof to Julie Goodliffe by May 15 <sup>th</sup> , 2019, 11:59pm.
<b>What May Students Apply for that is Not Allowed for FAIP?</b>	Internships, internal fellowships/scholarships, grants for which they are not PI.
<b>When Will Students Receive the Money?</b>	\$500 (or \$1,000 for two) one week after the FAIP deadline, or after sending proof of application, whichever is later. \$1,500 by May 22 <sup>nd</sup> , 2019.
<b>How will students find fellowships?</b>	Attend training workshops in the Center for Graduate Life: September 17 <sup>th</sup> at 12:30, or September 28 <sup>th</sup> at 11:30. Make appointments with <a href="#">Julie Goodliffe</a> or <a href="#">Jennifer Johnson</a> .
